Why Saṃskṛtam?

Saṃskṛta is not a mere language for day-to-day transactions, but a repository of vast Indian knowledge in Veda-s, Śāstra-s, Mathematics, Science, Astronomy, Yoga, Āyurveda and much more.

A recent scientific study "**Yoga and Saṃskṛta**" by Dr. Latha Sathish explores the interconnection between Yoga practices and **Saṃskṛta as a language**. It emphasizes Saṃskṛta's significance in conveying the authentic essence of Yogic teachings, mantra-s, and philosophical concepts.

The study examines how **Saṃskṛta's systematic pronunciation rules** train the learner's ability to recognize, differentiate, and produce sounds with exceptional accuracy. Precise phonetic arrangement of Saṃskṛta syllables creates vibrations that enhance meditation, mental clarity and neurocognitive harmony.

The above said study was done on **two groups** of students. "One group of students was asked to choose some favourite English word to repeat, while the other group was taught to chant Sarasvatī Mantra. Children were asked to repeat these regularly for several days". After the final analysis, there was very positive improvement in the students who **chanted the Sarasvatī mantra**, when compared to the other group of children.

What is Samskr̥tam ?

In the previous newsletters we saw the Bhāratīya Jñāna Paramparā (IKS) framework, the details about Veda-s and their branches. In this newsletter let us get an introduction to Vedāᅅga-s. The Vedāᅅga-s are six disciplines that support the understanding and proper application of the Vedic texts. There are 6 Vedāᅅga-s

1. **Chandas** (Prosody / metrical rules),
2. **Kalpa** (Procedure for performance of vedic rituals),
3. **Jyotiṣa** (Astronomy and Astrology),
4. **Nirukta** (Etymology),
5. **Śikṣā** (Science of pronunciation) and
6. **Vyākaraᅅa** (Grammar).

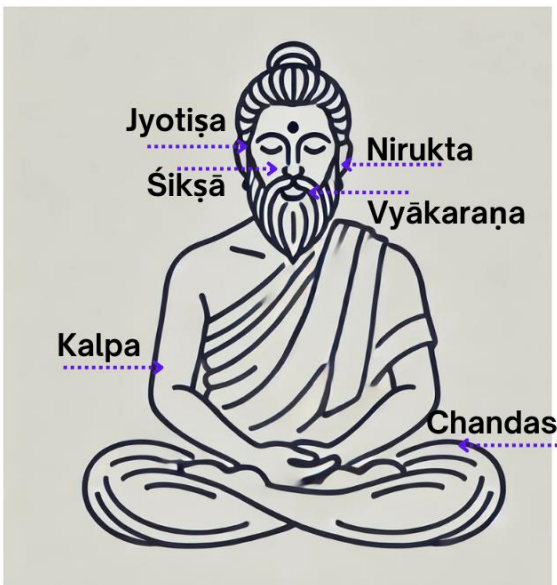

(Chandas is considered the feet of the Veda, while Kalpa is the hand; Jyotiṣa is the eye, and Nirukta is the ear. Śikṣā is the nose of the Veda, and Vyākaraᅅa is considered its mouth. Therefore, one who studies the Veda-s along with the Vedāᅅga-s thoroughly is esteemed in the realm of Brahman.)



The Vedāᅅga-s related to **Śikṣā** and **Chandas** ensure the Vedic mantra-s are recited exactly as they were intended, preserving their form. **Vyākaraᅅa** and **Nirukta** help in understanding and interpreting the the Veda-s, safeguarding the integrity of their meaning. The Vedāᅅga-s **Kalpa** and **Jyotiṣa** provide guidelines for the proper performance of Vedic rituals, helping protect their correct application in practice.

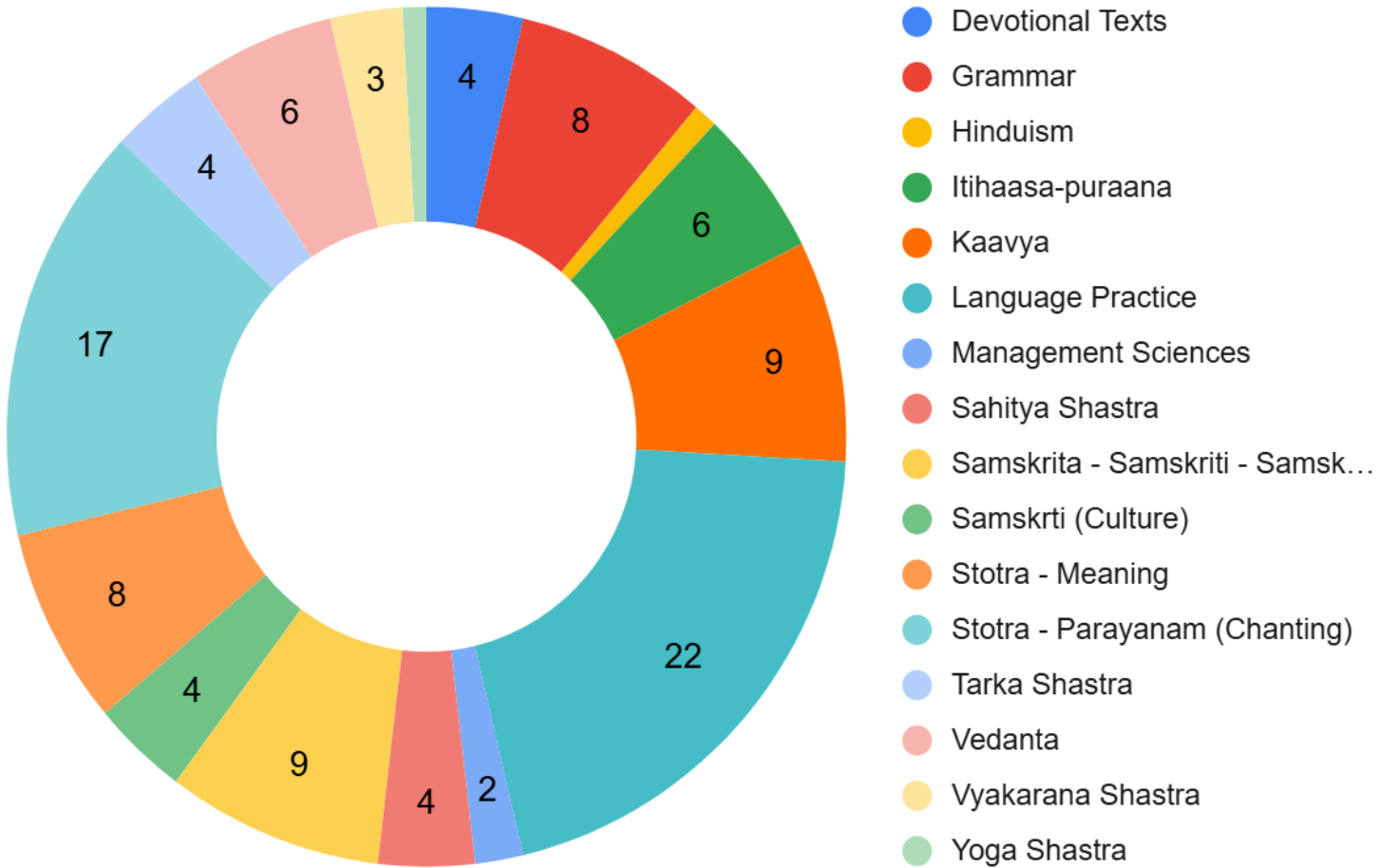
