Vyoma Linguistic Labs Foundation has been dedicated to the promotion of **Saṃskṛta** (Sanskrit), **Saṃskṛti** (culture), and **Saṃskāra** (values) since 2012. Key Activities of Vyoma

1. **Courses:** Over 400 structured courses on Sanskrit language, grammar, stotras, poetry, and various śāstras, taught by more than 100 expert teachers.
2. **Free Access:** Recordings of most lessons are available without restrictions on YouTube.
3. **Mobile Education:** A free app (available for both Android and iOS) that provides convenient access to study materials.
4. **Customized Programs:** Tailored programs for diverse groups, including children, students, professionals, homemakers, and senior citizens.
5. **Learning Progression:** Systematic study progressing through three levels—language study, textual study, and śāstra study—enabling learners to apply their knowledge effectively.
6. **Exam Preparation:** Training for Sanskrit board and society exams conducted by various sabhās and academic bodies.
7. **Building the Future:** Sustained after-school engagement for children through Vyoma Bāla Gurukula.

8. **Indian Knowledge Systems:** Programs designed around classical texts such as the Rāmāyaṇa, Bhagavadgītā, and Arthaśāstra to disseminate India's wisdom traditions.
9. **Stotra Chanting:** Numerous courses emphasizing the multi-faceted benefits of proper Sanskrit pronunciation.
10. **Audio-Visual Tools:** Pronunciation resources developed by Vedic scholars for precise learning.
11. **Publications:** Fifteen books published to date on stotras, grammar, and Sanātana Dharma.
12. **Multimedia Tools:** Interactive animations, games, and activities that make language learning enjoyable for children and adults alike.
13. **Sanskrit Language Labs:** Advanced resources for Sanskrit learning established in schools and colleges.
14. **Outreach Efforts:** Extending efforts to promote Sanskrit, culture, and values in rural areas as well as urban centers.
